

Preconstruction Today

- "Pre-construction is the first phase of the overall planning, coordination, and control of a construction job." (Gerardi2021)
- "Preconstruction considerations: Estimation, Safety, Logistics and Scheduling."; "The preliminary <u>risk</u> analysis (PRA) during the preconstruction phase is critical to project success and profit. (Schlesier 2019)
- "The relative involvement of preconstruction services required is dependent on the delivery method" (Hotter 2019)
- "Preconstruction should involve preconstruction managers, estimating, project managers, superintendents and specialty managers as required by the project. Each of these roles add significant value when they are involved early.
 - Preconstruction managers –Lead the process, leverage their expertise from a wholistic project perspective and ensure every team member stays on task to deliver on the client's vision
 - Estimating –Provides the real-time estimate detail, cost analysis and cost control for the project
 - Project managers and superintendents –Weigh in on schedule and constructability concerns for the project
 - Specialty managers –Managers with specified roles for quality assurance, engineering systems and 3D modeling add an extra layer of support and expertise for the project team to consider life-cycle costs, long-term durability and early coordination" (Stanton 2019)

Preconstruction Today

- Expectations of a preconstruction estimator extends to "filling in the blanks, defining the scopes of work, assessing alternative materials, systems or methods, and managing the intent of the design team and desires of the owner" (Kuhn 2007)
- Preconstruction Phase Schedule Management is one of the key roles of the preconstruction manager. (Kuhn 2007)
- Preconstruction services may include: Initial Meeting & Regular Follow-ups, An Overall Evaluation of the Project, Creating an Initial Schematic Design, Initial Budget Estimates, Selecting Materials & Equipment, Value Engineering, Site Analysis, Getting the Proper Approvals, Thorough Review of Design Documents, Set a Preliminary Schedule, Establishing a Final Budget, Procurement Management, Bid Packaging, Safety Considerations. (Gerardi2021)

Preconstruction Manager

 "Although many preconstruction managers possess an estimating background, more and more are field operations staff seeking a career change from onsite project management roles." (Kuhn 2007)

• "Beyond Design-Bid-Build, estimating becomes a process rather than a singular bid day event to be managed. This **extended and enhanced role demands that preconstruction professionals wear many hats beyond that of just "estimator**"." (Kuhn 2007)

 "Unlike Design-Bid-Build estimators, preconstruction managers at early stages of design rely on historical data and experience to quickly develop required alternate approaches and solutions from similar projects." (Kuhn 2007)






